Getting there

Use public transportation since there are no parking spaces available.

- → with your start card you have received a ticket by email, valid from
 - 26.09 (00:01 am) 30.09. (03:00 am) in fare zone ABC

- → Platz der Luftbrücke (U-Bahn, Bus), Tempelhof (S-Bahn, Bus)

Entrance

- → your start card = your entry ticket
- ➔ free admission for accompanying persons
- → allowed bag size max. 55x40x25 cm (equals hand luggage size)
 → larger bags can be stored in front of the entrance for a fee of 2 €
- → pets are not allowed on the EXPO site
- → click here for full <u>list of prohibited items</u>

Offering

- → many exhibitors from the areas of endurance, nutrition, sporting goods, health, sports travel and more

- You can drop off well-preserved sports shoes or sneakers at the SCC EVENTS booth (hangar 6) at MARATHON EXPO. The Berliner Stadtmission will collect the donations and pass them to those in need.

RACE MATERIAL

You'll receive your race material only at the MARATHON EXPO and only personally upon presentation of your start card and ID. Race material pick-up for Skaters only on Thursday & Friday.

You'll need

- → your start card → which you received by email and which is available for download in your user account under "My registrations"
- → your ID

You'll get

- → athletes wristband → will be put on you at the entrance and may not be taken off until you have finished on race day
- → your personal bib number in duplicate → may not be altered in any way and is not permitted to be given to another person
- ightarrow transponder for timekeeping on the back of your bib number ightarrow do not bend
- ➔ Helm sticker with your number
- ightarrow wristband to count your laps in the race ightarrow move the clip after each lap
- → transparent clothing bag & label with your number, to drop-off your stuff on race day
- ➔ goodie bag with information & treats from our sponsors

Pre-ordered extras & merchandise

 can only be picked-up at the MARATHON EXPO (no later collection, no shipping)

you will receive pre-ordered items from the **event collection** (event shirt, finisher shirt, legend jacket) directly with your bib number → pick-up with QR code in your start card

pre-ordered **merchandise** (Lustiges Taschenbuch, Buddy Bear etc.) is available at the booth in the entrance hall → pick-up with QR code in your start card

Bottle to keep you hydrated during the race is handed out in the INLINE VILLAGE → Voucher on your bib number




BEFORE THE START



THIS IS WHAT YOU MUST HAVE WITH YOU:

→ your 2 personal bib numbers

- \rightarrow both numbers must be worn during the race
- ightarrow attach each bib number clearly visible on the outside of your thighs in an upright position
- → official athletes wristband of the event (which you have received at the MARATHON EXPO)
- → Helmet! → Helmets are mandatory! Further protective clothing is recommended.
- → sticker for your helmet

Getting there:

Please use public transportation

→ your bib number is valid for public transport in fare zone ABC

Nearby stations

- → Hauptbahnhof (Main station), Friedrichstraße, Brandenburger Tor
- → Click here for trip planner

Hydration systems:

- You can contribute to the avoidance of plastic waste by using a hydration system (backpack, vest, belt) to provide yourself with water.
- → allowed are systems with a maximum total volume of 3 liters
- → refilling is possible at all supply and refreshment points

EVENT SITE

For security reasons only participants with official bib number and athletes wristband are allowed on the event site. Accompanying persons will not be admitted.

- → entrance possible from 10:45 am
- ···· → only one entrance: on the north side, at Paul-Löbe-Allee in front of the Bundeskanzleramt

Please note:

Anyone leaving the start area for the purpose of a warm-up must re-enter the area via the only access in the north (Paul-Löbe-Allee).

Clothing drop-off

- → Clothes can only be dropped-off in the official, transparent clothing bag of the BMW BERLIN-MARATHON 2024 (will be given to you with your race materials)
- → plus 1 bag for skates
- The "Berliner Stadtmission" collects clothing in good condition. Keep yourself warm with a hoodie, training jacket & co. in the pre-start zone and then donate these clothings on site.

In the start area you will find changing tents and toilets. There will be no warming foils spent.

START

- → skaters will start in 4 waves, which are divided in starting blocks
 - \rightarrow you can find the the start times at: www.skating.bmw-berlin-marathon.com/en/your-race/start
- \rightarrow your starting block is marked with a letter (A-F) on your bib number → changes are not possible

Time measurement will be switched off approx. 15 minutes after the last start, which means a late start is not possible.



ON THE COURSE



Not permitted are:

- → accompanying vehicles of any kind
- strollers or baby joggers, skateboards or other rolling devices (except skates, handbikes and wheelchairs in the respective competitions)
- → animals
- → Headphones → We would like to point out that the international organization World Athletics prohibits wearing headphones during athletics competitions.

Route:

- → 7K circuit between Siegessäule and Richard-Wagner-Platz which must be completed a total of 5 times
 - \rightarrow you are responsible for counting your 5 laps yourself \rightarrow the number will be checked afterwards via the timing system
 - → keep track with the wristband, which you received with your race material → push the clip onwards each time you round the Victory Column
 - ightarrow also check the distance you have covered with your watch
- → Exit after after 5 laps around the Siegessäule and 35K on the final stretch to the finish
 - ightarrow to avoid crossings when pulling out, the following lane division applies on the
 - Straße des 17. Juni in the direction of Siegessäule
 - left lane = fast skater
 - middle lane = slow skaters
 - right lane = skaters on the last lap

DANGEROUS POINTS

On the circuit:

- → Großer Stern/Siegessäule: Entry from the start and exit in the direction of Hofjägerallee (to the finish) + roadworks on the right at the Großer Stern exit heading west
- → Straße des 17. Juni: roadworks with lane narrowing in both directions to/from Klopstockstraße
- → Ernst-Reuter-Platz: traffic circle
- → west turn
 - central island at sharp right turn into Wintersteinstraße
 - · central island shortly before the left-hand bend into Brauhofstraße
 - Narrower road to Otto-Suhr-Allee

From the circuit to the finish:

- → GKM 36 Hofjägerallee/Tiergartenstraße Lane change
- → KM 37 Left turn into narrow Von-der-Heydt-Straße
- → KM 39 Leipziger Straße Tram tracks parallel to Wilhemstraße
- → KM 40 Entrance to Jerusalemer Straße
- → KM 41 Markgrafenstraße with central island

Please follow the rules of conduct to ensure a safe race.

RULES OF CONDUCT

→ keep on the right and let faster skaters pass on the left (as in road traffic)

·····

- → do not skate next to each other, but in slipstream to leave room for passing
- → announce overtaking by shouting
- → avoid cutting curves
- → look over your shoulder before changing lanes

Hand signal:

- → both arms pointing to left or right = left or right turn
- → moving both arms sideways up & down = let them roll pay special attention!
- → both arms up = Attention! Slow down! Brake if necessary!
- > one hand pointing down = pothole/ road gully or similar
- → arm pointing to the side = participant wants to leave or join group

TIMEKEEPING

Control points:

→ one point on the circuit which must be run over 5 times → missing split times will result in disqualification

Time limit:

2:10 h (after crossing the start mat)

→ Cut-off points at KM 29 at 2: 59 pm and at KM 36 at 3:21 pm → Participants who have not reached this points by that time will be taken off the race

REFRESHMENTS

- → one point on the circuit with drinks & fruit
- → refill your bottle
- → at the end of are toilets available

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

:

- → First Aid Point on the circuit at and after Ernst-Reuter-Platz on the right-hand side
- → First Aid Points on the final stretch at Leipziger Straße and before Brandenburger Tor

..... The medical staff is authorized and obliged to remove participants with signs of injury and/or overexertion from the race. Please contact the staff if you have any complaints or notice any emergencies among others.

YOU WILL GET

- → vour medal
- → refreshments with drinks and fruit
- → your clothing bag on presentation of your bib number until 3:55 pm
- → if needed: warming foil

After use, drop the foil in the designated bins to help with recycling.

In the finish area you will find changing tents (unguarded) and a free massage service. There are no showers on site.

You got everything? After leaving the event area, no new access is possible.


